To Whom It May Concern:

This questionnaire pertains to fine denier polyester staple fiber ("fine denier PSF"). The United States International Trade Commission is investigating fine denier PSF under section 202 of the Trade Act of 1974 (19 U.S.C. § 2252).

In this proceeding, the Commission must determine whether fine denier PSF is being imported into the United States in such increased quantities as to be a substantial cause of serious injury or the threat of serious injury to the domestic industry producing such product. The Commission has posted its notice of this proceeding (attached) on its website (www.usitc.gov) and published it in the *Federal Register* (89 FR 18435, March 13, 2024).

The confidential business information you supply in this questionnaire or in connection therewith will be so treated by the Commission and will not be disclosed except as may be required by law. Your response will be consolidated with the responses of other firms and will form much of the statistical base for the Commission's determination.
